ILIC Legislative Committee – Call Summary

June 7, 2019

Lawmakers adjourned the spring session on Sunday, June 2 after the Senate passed the remaining pieces of a FY 2020 budget and implementation package and a new capital spending and revenue plan (which includes gaming expansion, as well as increases in the motor fuel tax and registration fees).

ILIC previously circulated an end of session summary (on Monday) along with a list of key bills passed both houses, as well as those key bills that did not advance this session.

Both the House and Senate are not scheduled to return until the two- week fall veto session, which has been set for October 28 - 30 and November 12 - 14.

Lawmakers could schedule House and Senate subject matter hearings over the summer, so ILIC will continue to monitor and participate (as appropriate) in any committees/topics of interest.

Data Privacy/Cybersecurity:

As noted previously, <u>HB 3358 (Turner/T. Cullerton)</u> was held in the Senate to continue discussions over the summer with various stakeholders to craft data privacy protections for consumers. ILIC will set up a call on this issue for interested members later this month to begin discussions on how the Council can best advocate for appropriate changes (pursuing changes to <u>SB 1624 (Glowiak/Andrade)</u>, which updates breach notification requirements, will also be a part of this discussion).

This issue will also be a topic of discussion at the upcoming annual conference, and members will have an opportunity to discuss with the Department of Insurance their potential engagement on pursuing the NAIC insurance data security model law.

Excepted Benefits:

<u>HB 1639 (DeLuca/Mulroe)</u> passed both houses on May 31, so it will now go to the Governor for approval. ILIC will work with the Governor's office and other stakeholders (NFIB, the Chamber, IL Insurance Agents, etc) to weigh in in support of enactment.
